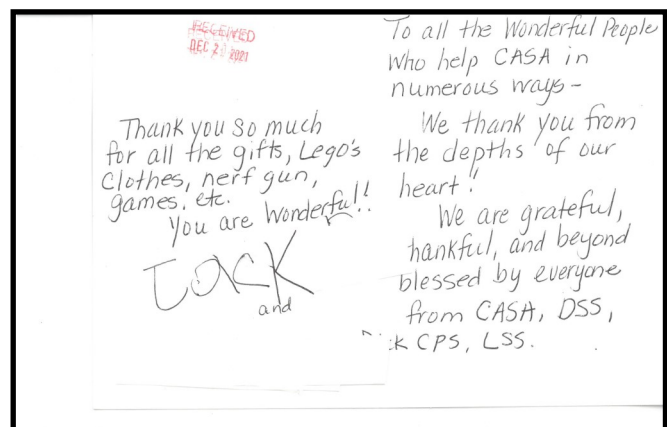
## Our volunteers are amazing!

The heart and soul of every CASA program is its volunteers. We think NHCASA has some of the best! Here are just a few examples:

After only a few short weeks of being sworn in as a brand-new volunteer, this CASA eagerly accepted her first appointment, which involved four children under the age of 7, in different placements. This volunteer went above and beyond the requirements of a CASA. She helped DSS with transportation, played a mediator role between foster parents, and offered respite care in order to give the providers a much-needed break. She initiated numerous contacts, which resulted in a record-breaking 42-page CASA Report. She advocated heavily for enhancing the sibling relationships and planned play dates so the kids could see each other. She always kept the best interests of each individual child at the forefront and underwent a grueling cross-examination during testimony. Even though it was an extremely difficult case, she always kept a cool and calm composure, while seeking to help the children through her nurturing demeanor. This CASA volunteer is truly one-of-a-kind and has a heart of gold. Her detailed documentation earned her rave reviews from the Court.

A CASA volunteer provided advocacy for three children on a case that opened due to a mother's methamphetamine use. The mother completed a chemical dependency program and participated in individual counseling as a means to address her depression. The CASA fought hard for the children to return to their mother's care on an in-home safety plan through a trial reunification, all of which would be under the premise the mother continue with her therapy and outpatient treatment. Trust was established between the mother and the CASA. The case was eventually closed with a successful reunification. The volunteer played an essential role in this case, as she provided resources, support, and recommendations for services, for the children and the mother. These advocacy efforts resulted in a positive outcome for the entire family unit.

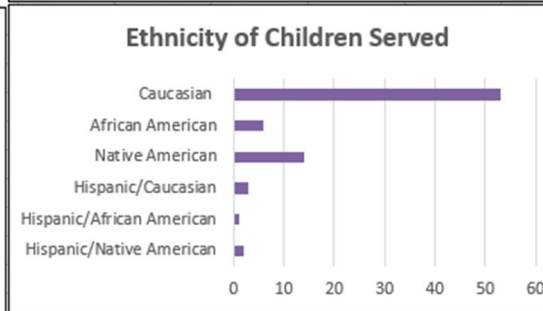
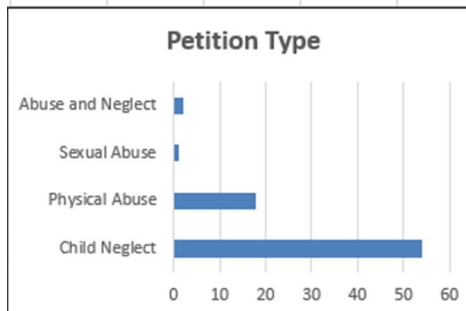
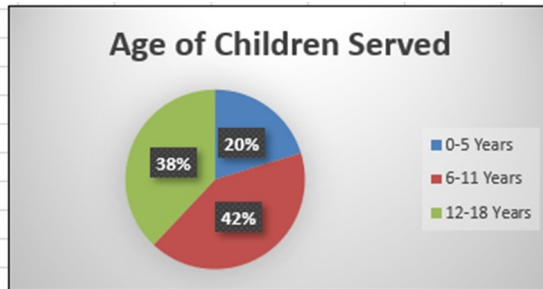
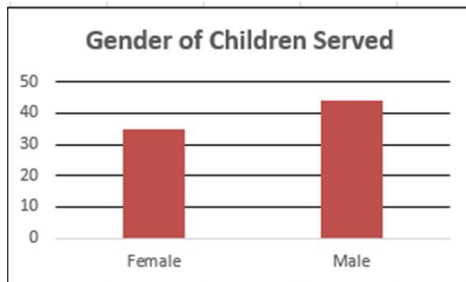
## By the Numbers

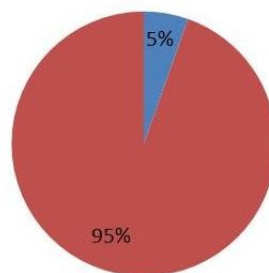


## How NHCASA funds are earned and spent:



### Cost of Supporting One Volunteer

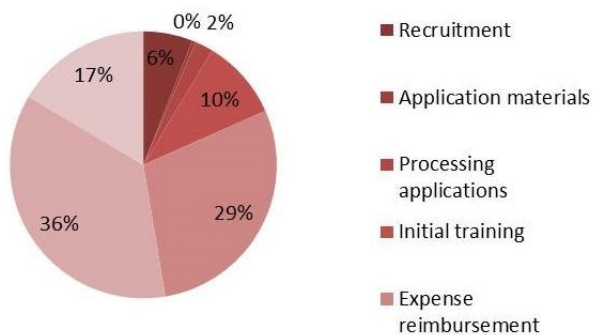
■ Administrative ■ Direct Service

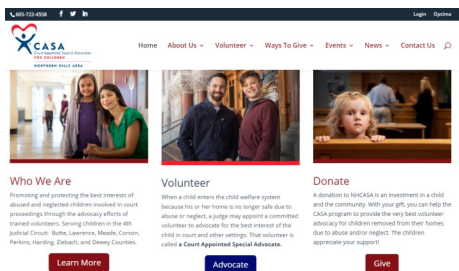
